The basis for refreshing the Statewide Program Goals and strategies of Service for the next three program years.

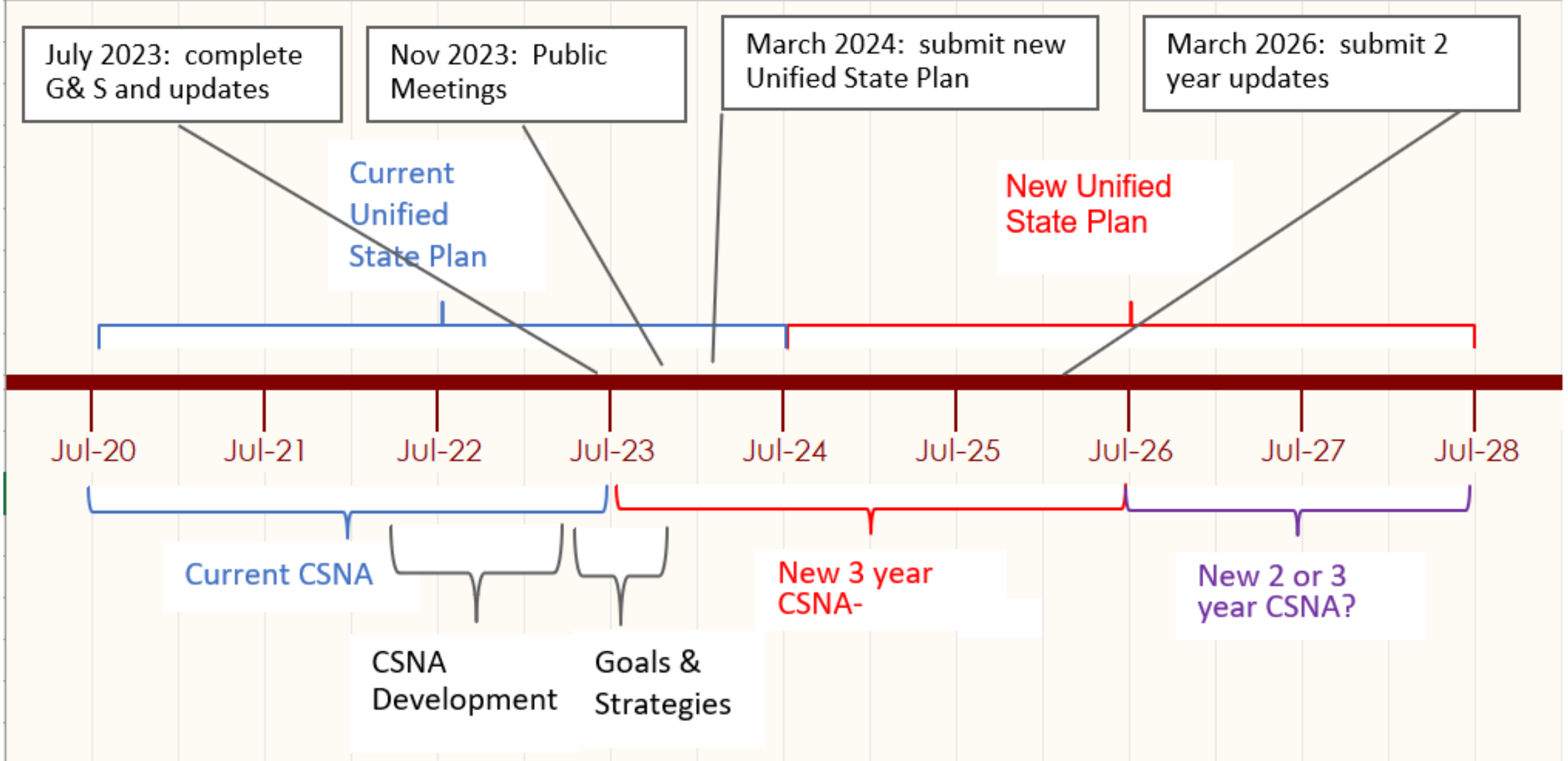
CSNA Goals (Federal)

- Identifying the rehabilitation needs of individuals with disabilities, particularly the vocational rehabilitation services needs of :
 - individuals with **most significant disabilities**, including their need for supported employment services
 - **minorities**
 - individuals with disabilities who have been **unserved or underserved** by VR
 - individuals with disabilities served through other components of the **statewide workforce investment system**
 - **Youth and students** served through pre-employment, other transitions or IDEA coordinated programs
- Identifying needs for establishing, developing, or improving community rehabilitation programs within the state
