

WIOA YOUTH PROGRAM ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE DEFINITION

SCOPE: WIOA Title I Youth Program

EFFECTIVE DATE: July 1, 2015

STATUTORY AUTHORITY

Department of Labor Employment and Training Administration Federal Register §681.300 & §681.310

OBJECTIVE

To define Additional Assistance and establish documentation requirements for the WIOA Youth Program eligibility.

COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

WIOA Regulation §681.300 provides State Boards with the authority to define and establish documentation requirements for additional assistance.

Additional assistance shall be defined as an individual who meets one or more of the following:

- A. No employment within the last 6 months
- B. Has a record of not being able to hold employment due to being fired, or quitting two or more jobs in the last six months
- C. Has a history of substance abuse
- D. Having one or more parents currently incarcerated
- E. Is a veteran

Documentation requirements will include a case note in the participant's SDWORKS file outlining the Additional Assistance category that applies to the participant and the participant's situation related to the Additional Assistance.
